This Amendment No. 2 amends and supplements the statement on Schedule 13D, filed on May 31, 2011, as amended by Amendment No. 1 thereto filed on October 3, 2012 (collectively, the "Schedule 13D"), by New Mountain Finance Corporation, a Delaware corporation (the "Reporting Person")(1) with respect to the common membership units ("Units"), of New Mountain Finance Holdings, L.L.C., a Delaware limited liability company (the "Issuer"). Capitalized terms used herein but not defined shall have the meanings ascribed thereto in the Schedule 13D. Except as herein amended or supplemented, all other information in the Schedule 13D is as set forth therein.

Item 3. Source and Amount of Funds or Other Consideration

Item 3 of the Schedule 13D is hereby amended to add the following:

On December 7, 2012, the Reporting Person completed an underwritten public offering of 3,250,000 shares of its Common Stock at a public offering price of \$14.80 per share (the "Primary Offering"). As a result, pursuant to the LLC Agreement as described in Item 6, the Reporting person used the aggregate net proceeds (after deducting underwriting discounts and commissions) from the Primary Offering of \$46,644,000 to acquire 3,250,000 Units.

Item 5. Interest in Securities of the Issuer

Items 5(a) and 5(b) of the Schedule 13D are hereby amended and restated in their entirety as follows:

(a) – (b). The aggregate percentage of Units reported owned by the Reporting Person is based upon 40,162,573 Units outstanding, which is the total number of Units outstanding as of December 7, 2012.

For the aggregate number of securities of the Issuer beneficially owned, the percentage of the class of securities of the Issuer beneficially owned, the number of securities for which the Reporting Person has the sole power to vote or to direct the vote, the number of securities for which the Reporting Person has the shared power to vote or to direct the vote, the number of securities for which the Reporting Person has the shared power to dispose or to direct the disposition, and the number of securities for which the Reporting Person has the shared power to dispose or to direct the disposition, see the responses to Items 7 through Item 11 and Item 13 on the attached cover page.

Item 5(c) of the Schedule 13D is hereby amended to add the following:

On December 7, 2012, the Reporting Person completed the Primary Offering of 3,250,000 shares of its Common Stock at a public offering price of \$14.80 per share. As a result, pursuant to the LLC Agreement as described in Item 6, the Issuer issued 3,250,000 Units to the Reporting

Item 6. Contracts, Arrangements, Understandings or Relationships with Respect to Securities of the Issuer

Item 6 of the Schedule 13D is hereby amended to add the following:

In connection with the Primary Offering, the Reporting Person and the Issuer, among others, entered into an underwriting agreement, dated December 4, 2012, with certain underwriters (the "December 2012 Underwriting Agreement"). A more detailed summary of the December 2012 Underwriting Agreement is set forth in the Issuer's Prospectus dated December 4, 2012, as filed with the SEC on December 4, 2012. This summary is qualified in its entirety by the terms of the December 2012 Underwriting Agreement, which is set forth as Exhibit 99.5, and is incorporated herein by reference.

Item 7. Material to be Filed as Exhibits

Item 7 of the Schedule 13D is hereby amended to add the following:
